



Dear Student:

The SUCCEED Committee at Stolly Insurance Group awards two scholarships annually. The purpose of the **SUCCEED Scholarship** is to help young business leaders with their continuing education. The scholarship will be awarded for tuition to a post-secondary level institution.

There are two categories for which an applicant will be considered: 1) a young leader pursuing his or her post-secondary education that *is* related to a current or retired employee of Stolly Insurance Group; 2) a young leader pursuing his or her post-secondary education that *is not* related to a current or retired employee of Stolly Insurance Group.

The SUCCEED committee will review applications and vote on the winner of the scholarship each year. If a scholarship is not awarded in the current year, the money will be rolled back into the program for future scholarship distribution.

**Eligibility:**

Any Student graduating high school in 2018 who is a primary resident of Ohio and will enroll in post-secondary education for the 2018/2019 school year. The committee will take into consideration current grades, extracurricular activities, leadership, work ethic, and application/essay, and the applicant's commitment to continued education. Deadline for the application process will be March 9, 2018.

**Amount:** \$1000 per scholarship. The scholarship may be applied to tuition, room, or books.
